## Ornamentals With Drought-Tolerant Attributes

The following lists of trees, shrubs and flowers is a result of on-site evaluations conducted over the past several years. All plants have been observed growing in the former xeriscape/water conservation garden at the Cooperative Extension office in Plainview and in other local xeriscape-type gardens. During extended or periodic horticultural droughts (unless there are recent plantings), no supplemental water is applied. Such was the case in 2002 when mid-summer was overly dry. Plants became accustomed to a lot of spring rains (12+” in April, May and June). July and August showed excessive deficiencies of 1.2” for July and 3.1” for August; most of which did not arrive until the 29<sup>th</sup>. Rains then returned, but not before the damage from excessive summer heat and drought took their toll in our landscapes. (Remember, if it’s a one-time rain event for the month, there is always considerable run-off).

PLANTS IN BOLD were evaluated in 1999 as especially drought-resistant with no supplemental water.
